<b>STANDARD TURNAROUND TIME</b>	
<b>CLINICAL UTILITY</b>	This test is for the detection of CD40ligand (CD40L) mutations associated with X linked hyper-IgM syndrome (XHIGM). An immunodeficiency with most early reports showing patients had elevated serum immunoglobulin (Ig)M levels but markedly reduced IgG, IgA and IgE levels. However, according to the US XHIGM Registry report in 2003, elevated IgM levels were found in less than one third of patients. All patients had reduced levels of IgG and more than three fourths of patients had reduced levels of IgA. Patients with XHIGM have profound susceptibility to bacterial infections and an increased susceptibility to opportunistic infections.
